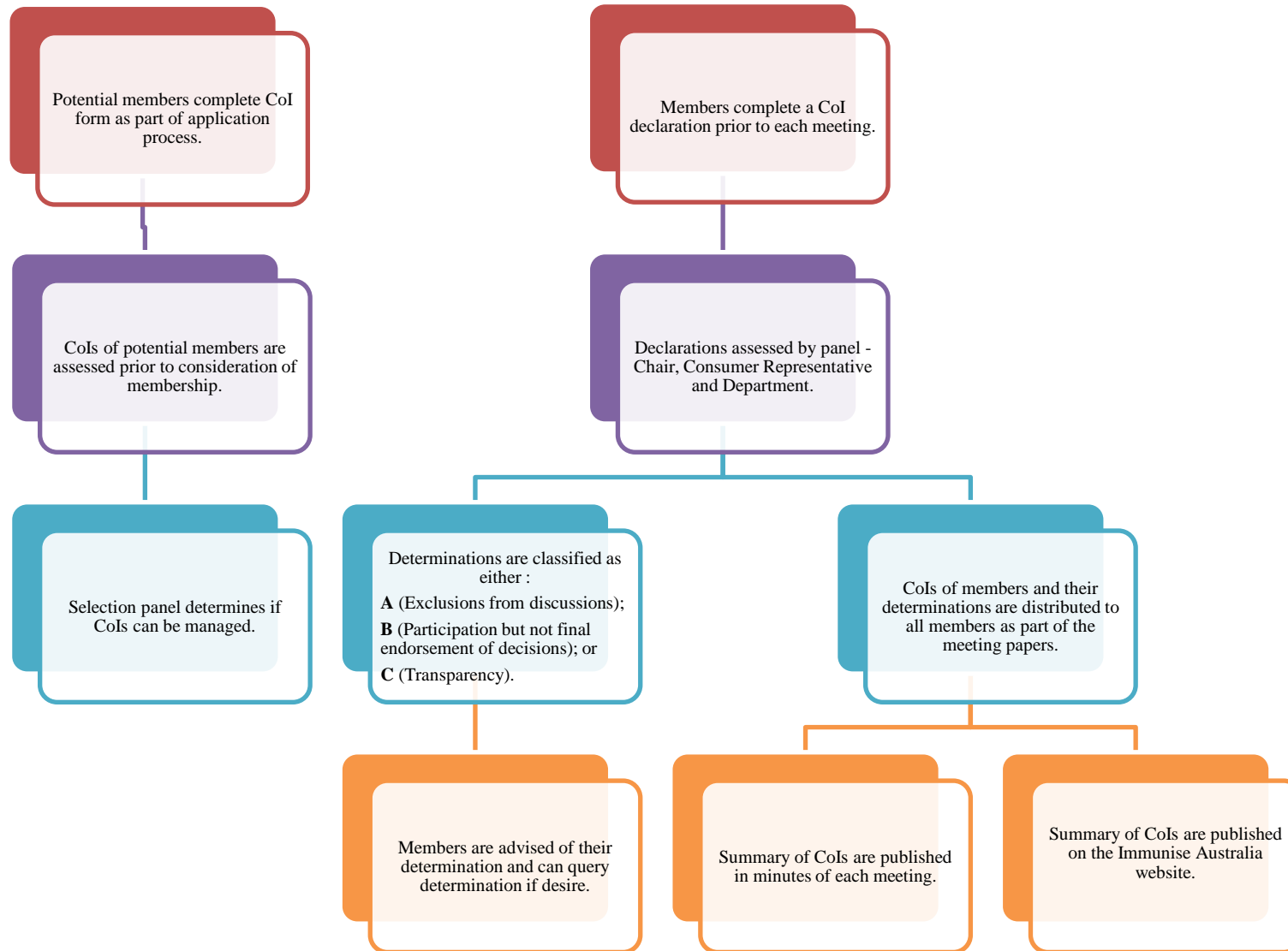


# ATAGI Conflict of Interest Procedures



This chart explains the ATAGI procedures for identification and management of the potential conflicts of interest (CoIs) declared by ATAGI members.

#### Step 1

Potential members complete CoI form as part of application process.

#### Step 2

CoIs of potential members are assessed prior to consideration of membership.

#### Step 3

Selection panel determines if CoIs can be managed.

#### Step 4

Members complete a CoI declaration prior to each meeting.

#### Step 5

Declarations assessed by panel - Chair, Consumer Representative and Department.

#### Step 6

Determinations are classified as either

A (Exclusions from discussions)

B (Participation but not final endorsement of decisions); or

C (Transparency).

#### Step 7

CoIs of members and their determinations are distributed to all members as part of the meeting papers.

Step 8

Members are advised of their determination and can query determination if desire.

Step 9

Summary of CoIs are published in minutes of each meeting.

Step 10

Summary of CoIs are published on the Immunise Australia website.
